AND NOW, this 19th day of July, 2017, upon consideration of Defendant Ortho-Clinical Diagnostics, Inc.'s Motion for Summary Judgment (Doc. No. 320, filed July 15, 2016), Defendant Ortho-Clinical Diagnostics, Inc.'s Memorandum in Support of Its Motion for Summary Judgment (Doc. No. 323, filed July 15, 2016), Plaintiffs' Response in Opposition to Ortho-Clinical Diagnostics, Inc.'s Motion for Summary Judgment (Doc. No. 329, filed September 16, 2016), and Defendant Ortho-Clinical Diagnostics, Inc.'s Reply Memorandum in Support of Its Motion for Summary Judgment (Doc. - 2. That part of Ortho-Clinical Diagnostics, Inc.'s Motion that seeks summary judgment as to plaintiffs' claims based on the 2005 and 2008 price increases is **GRANTED**.
- 3. That part of Ortho-Clinical Diagnostics, Inc.'s Motion that seeks summary judgment as to the fraudulent concealment issue is **DENIED**.
