**ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR (1) AN AWARD OF  
ATTORNEYS' FEES, (2) REIMBURSEMENT OF LITIGATION EXPENSES, AND  
(3) SERVICE AWARDS FOR THE CLASS REPRESENTATIVES**

WHEREAS, the Court has granted final approval to Plaintiffs' settlements with Immucor, Inc., dated January 11, 2012; and Ortho-Clinical Diagnostics, Inc., dated June 13, 2018 (collectively, the "Combined Settlements");

WHEREAS, Plaintiffs filed a Motion for (1) An Award of Attorneys' Fees, (2) Reimbursement of Litigation Expenses, and (3) Service Awards for the Class Representatives (the "Motion"),

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.
2. Terms used in this Order that are defined in the Motion are, unless otherwise defined herein, used in this Order as defined in the Motion.
3. The Court finds that the Notice provided to the Class of Class Counsel's request for an award of attorneys' fees, reimbursement of litigation expenses, and service awards for the Class Representatives meets the requirements of Rule 23 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure

and due process, was the best notice practicable under the circumstances, and constitutes due and sufficient notice to all persons entitled thereto.

4. Plaintiffs' Counsel (Class Counsel and supporting firms) are hereby awarded 33.33% of the Combined Settlement Fund, which amount equals \$13,833,333.33, plus accrued interest.

5. Plaintiffs' Counsel are hereby awarded litigation expenses in the amount of \$1,886,200.80 to be paid from the Combined Settlement Fund.<sup>1</sup>

7. The awards of attorney fees and expenses shall be allocated among Plaintiffs' Counsel by Class Counsel, Spector Roseman & Kodroff, P.C., in a manner that, in Class Counsel's good-faith judgment, reflects Plaintiffs' Counsel's contributions of time and money to the institution, prosecution and resolution of the litigation.

8. At the request and suggestion of Class Counsel, each of the named plaintiffs, F. Baragaño Pharmaceuticals, Inc., Community Medical Center Health Care System, Professional Resources Management of Crenshaw LLC d/b/a Crenshaw Community Hospital, Douglas County Hospital, Health Network Laboratories L.P., Larkin Community Hospital, Legacy Health System, Mary Hitchcock Memorial Hospital, Inc., Regional Medical Center Board d/b/a Northeast Alabama Regional Medical Center, Hospital Sisters Health System,<sup>2</sup> Schuylkill

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
